AFFIDAVIT OF COMMON LAW NAME CHANGE

Alaska Statute 01.10.010 provides:

So much of the common law not inconsistent with the Constitution of the State of Alaska or the Constitution of the United States or with any law passed by the legislature of the State of Alaska is the rule of decision in this state. **Roeckl v. FDIC, 885 P. 2d 1067 - Alaska: Supreme Court 1994** states:

[A]s a matter of common law, which "generally recognizes that persons may transact business under an assumed or fictitious name as long as fraud ... [is] not involved." Platt v. Locke, 11 Utah 2d 273, 358 P.2d 95, 98 (1961). The proposition appears to be well settled that "[i]n the absence of a statutory prohibition, a person, **without abandoning his real name**, may adopt or assume a name, and he may use such assumed name to identify himself in the transaction of his business, the execution of contracts and the carrying on of his affairs." Kreuter v. United States, 201 F.2d 33, 35 (10th Cir.1953).[6]

United States v. McKay 2 F.2d 257 further states:

Under the common law a man can change his name **at will**, provided it is not done with a fraudulent purpose; he may **sue and be sued by such adopted name**, **and will be bound by any contract into which he enters in his adopted name**. This is true in the absence of a restrictive statute, and is not abrogated by the fact that a procedure is provided by statute for the change of one's name. 20 Standard Ency. 250; In re McUlta (D. C.) 189 Fed. 250; Linton v. Bank (C. C.) 10 Fed. 894.
